Our goal is to Create a High School to Work Academic Programs for at Risk High School Students, to allow specific High School Students to enrolled in specific Classes required by our participating Businesses, particularly Small Manufacturing Businesses in 36 States across the United States.

Our goal is to work with Public High Schools in over 36 States across the United States and work with the U.S. Justice Department, to work with State, County, and City Governments, to analyze the U.S. Crime Statistics to identify what Middle School Students that have immediate Family Members or extended Family Members that are either on Probation or Parole, as a Means Text as a selective just way for the High School Student to Qualify for our proposed High School to Work Academic Program.

30 Historical Black Colleges are the Primary Educational Institutions that will be offered a Procurement Contract with The Workplace Educational Products Company, to procure a minimum of Six (6) Educational Institution U.S. GSA Contract – Grant Writing Partners in each of our thirty - six (36) States.

* Three (3) Junior College Grant Writing Partner Contracts in two (2) States 6 Total

* Three (3) Vocational Trade School Grant Writing Partner Contracts in two (2) States 6 Total

6 Junior Colleges and Vocational Trade Schools for each Historical Black College per State = 7

252 Educational Institutions minimum Grant Writing Partner Contracts for our 36 States = 7 x 36

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Historical Black Colleges that become a primary Educational Institution in a U.S. State market area, will Partner with at least three (3) Junior Colleges and three (3) Vocational Trade Schools to establish a seven (7) Educational Institution High School to Work Contract Procurement Group.

Each Educational Institution High School to Work Contract Procurement Group as a prerequisite for the U.S. General Service Administration (G.S.A.) Grant Writing Partner Contract, will each procure a minimum of three (3) Small Manufacturing Businesses to become Partners with High School to Work Employer Partners initiative with The Workplace Educational Products Company.

Our goal for each Educational Institution High School to Work Procurement Group, is to Partner with a minimum of twenty (21) Small Manufacturing Businesses in each State Contract market area.

Each Educational Institution Small Manufacturing Business High School to Work Contract Procurement Group, will use the **State Manufacturers Directory** in each State as the **Reference Source** to call to enroll Small Manufacturing Businesses to become participants in our U.S. General Services Administration (G.S.A.) High School to Work Academic Curriculum and Social Service Counseling Grant Writing Partner.

Our goal is to enroll a minimum of 21 Small Manufacturing Businesses in each State in our 36 State market areas, to have a minimum total of 756 Small Manufacturing Businesses in which to give the National Statistical Average of **2,682,000** High School Students that Dropout or don't finish High School on time, the opportunity to be enrolled in a High School Curriculum that will give the High School Students Prep Courses to Qualify for our High School to Work with Small Manufacturing Businesses.
